## **ROBOTIC DINOSAURS MODELS**

Pushpa Gujral Science City (PGSC) invites tenders from reputed Agencies for providing Robotic Dinosaurs at the Science City.

An artificial lake (Water Body) has island on which Dinosaurs Park has been created having natural flora and more than 45 life size models of various dinosaurs ranging from 1 foot to 150 feet in length providing very picturesque scene for the visitors. The Dinosaurs Park is the major attraction among the public visiting Science City.



More than 3.25 Lacs visitors visit the Science City annually. Visitors generally spend 6 to 7 hours in the Science City.

## SCOPE OF WORK and TERM & CONDITIONS

### 1. Scope of Work

Tenders are invited for setting up of life-size Robotic Dinosaurs models and their operation for duration of contract period on PPP mode in Science City, Kapurthala, Punjab from reputed firms.

1.1 **Robotic Dinosaurs Models** will be life size having multiple motions like eyes blinking, head moving, tail swinging, breathing effect etc. These models will be located outdoor and should be able to withstand extreme weather and rain conditions. The material / paint to be used should be weather and rain resistant and robust. Along with this the look of Models should be as of real living dinosaurs. PGSC is looking for the following outdoor robotic models of dinosaurs at Dinosaurs Park on the island in Science City, Kapurthala:

#### a. Tyrannosaurus (T Rex)

**Tyrannosaurus** is a dinosaur and dates back to upper Cretaceous Period, 68 to 66 million years ago.

Movements: Eyes blinking, Opening closing movement of mouth with emulating sound. Movement of front claws and sways up and down, swaying of tail, breathing movement of stomach.

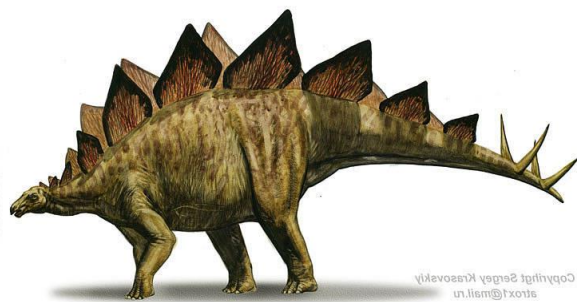


Material: Robust Steel structure inside and silica gel outside with durable motors (Microchip controlled / digital controlled movements)

Dimension: Length: 6m, Height: 4 m and Breadth: 1.30 m

#### b. Stegosaurus

**Stegosaurus** is a type of armored dinosaur of the Late Jurassic period between 155 and 150 million years ago. Stegosaurus had plates that were embedded in its back.



Movements: Eyes blinking, Opening closing movement of mouth with emulating sound. Movement of front claws and sways up and down, swaying of tail, breathing movement of stomach.

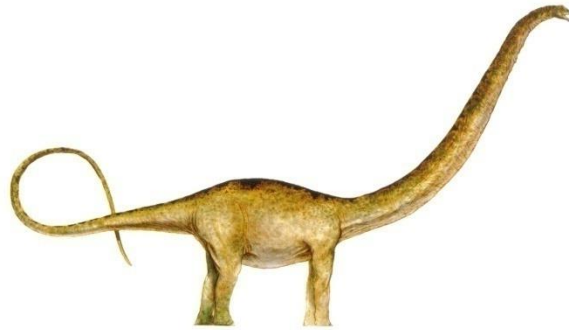
Material: Robust Steel structure inside and silica gel outside with durable motors (Microchip controlled / digital controlled movements)

Dimension: Length: 5 m, Height: 1 m and Breadth: 1 m

### c. Mamenchisaurus

**Mamenchisaurus** is

a [sauropod dinosaur](#) known for their remarkably long [necks](#) which made up half the total body length and dates back to late cretaceous 160 to 145 [million years ago](#).



Movements: Eyes blinking, Opening closing movement of mouth with emulating sound. Movement of front claws and sways up and down, swaying of tail, breathing movement of stomach.

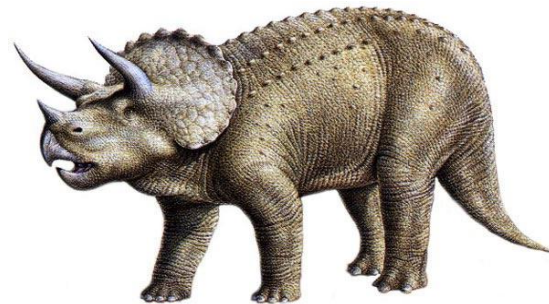
Material: Robust Steel structure / frame inside and silica gel outside with durable motors (Microchip controlled / digital controlled movements)

Dimension: Length: 10 m, Height: 5 m and Breadth: 2 m

### d. Triceratops

**Triceratops** is

a [genus](#) of [herbivorous ceratopsid dinosaur](#) that first appeared during the late [Cretaceous period](#), about 68 [million years ago](#).



Movements: Eyes blinking, Opening closing movement of mouth with emulating sound. Movement of front claws and sways up and down, swaying of tail, breathing movement of stomach.

Material: Robust Steel structure inside and silica gel outside with durable motors (Microchip controlled / digital controlled movements)

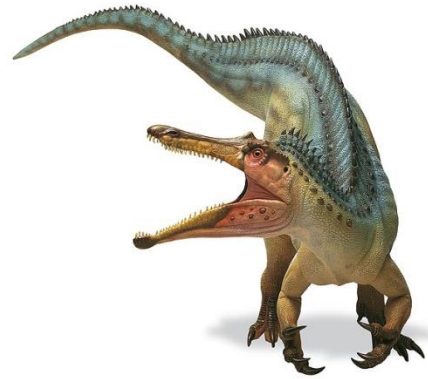
Dimension: Length: 5 m, Height: 2 m and Breadth: 1 m



**e. Baryonyx**

**Baryonyx** is lived in the early [Cretaceous Period](#), about 130–125 million years ago.

Movements: Eyes blinking, Opening closing movement of mouth with emulating sound. Movement of front claws and sways up and down, swaying of tail, breathing movement of stomach.



Material: Robust Steel structure inside and silica gel outside with durable motors (Microchip controlled / digital controlled movements)

Dimension: Length: 5 m, Height: 2 m and Breadth: 1 m

**f. Moving Dinosaur**

Manually operated Dinosaurs by operator inside the model having moments of eye, head, mouth opening and closing and swaying of tail.

Material: Steel frame structure, sponge, silicon. Camera connected with monitor for display inside and fan and air holes for easy breathing of operator.

Dimension: Length: 4 m, Height: 1.8 m

Operation: Required Trained operators for operations of moving dinosaur model will be provided by the Contractor. Contractor will be responsible for the safe, secure and conducive conditions and environment in the model.

- 1.2 To start up above mentioned numbers and types of Robotic Dinosaurs Models are sufficient. Firm can increased or have other type of models or other facilities / activities with the demand and to make it more attractive for visitors with mutual consent of Firm and PGSC.

### 1.3 Operations of the Robotic Dinosaurs Models

- 1.3.1 Firm will be responsible for setting up the Robotic Dinosaurs Models
- 1.3.2 Operations of these models during the working hours of the Science City.
- 1.3.3 Regular maintenance and up keep of models.
- 1.3.4 Down time for any model will not be more than 7 days. If more time is required for repairing the model then it will be substituted by another similar model.
- 1.3.5 The models remaining non functional more than 7 days the share of successful bidder will be deducted for the downtime period as follows

- 1.3.6 Contractor will be solely responsible for the safety of the operators and for any miss-happening will indemnify PGSC.
- 1.3.7 Firm will also promote its facility at the Science City for bringing more visitors to the Science City. A promotional report with expense details shall be provided to the Science City half yearly.

### 1.4 Other Works

- 1.4.1 PGSC will provide required power Mains Line at a single point on the island with the circuit breaker. The firm will supply and install all the electricity fittings including wiring and cabling as required by using proper sized wires and cables conforming Indian Standard to the location of Robotic Dinosaurs through camouflaged and safe manner.
- 1.4.2 Associated accessories required, if any, to complete the above work would be arranged by the Firm at his /her own cost.
- 1.4.3 Firm shall arrange for transportation, loading and unloading and safe storage of material at site at his own cost.
- 1.4.4 TO GET THE CLEAR IDEA OF THE WORK FIRMS ARE REQUESTED TO VISIT THE SCIENCE CITY, KAPURTHALA TO SEE THE SITE.
- 1.4.5 All Civil, electrical and mechanical work (machines, equipment, pumps etc) as required for the setting up of the Robotic Dinosaurs Models shall have to be done by the Firm.
- 1.4.6 Such works, not listed in the schedule of work but required for completion of the project is deemed to have been included in the scope of this bid.
- 1.4.7 The work shall be carried out under the direction and supervision of the PGSC, Kapurthala. On acceptance of the tender, the contractor shall intimate

the name of his accredited representative who would be supervising the installation and operations.

- 1.4.8 **The PGSC reserves to itself the right of omitting altogether any item of work at the time of award of the work or at later date and the contractor shall not be entitled for any compensation due to this omission.**

## **2. Revenue Sharing**

- 2.1 Additional ticket for this facility (Robotic Dino) will be Rs. 35/- (inclusive of share / taxes etc.) and will be issued along with the Package as well as entry ticket. So that all the visitors entering the Science City with Entry Ticket or Package Ticket will be entitled to see this facility.
- 2.2 Firm will quote PGSC Share on additional ticket cost Rs. 35/-.
- 2.3 Minimum Reserved PGSC Share on additional ticket is 20%, any agency quoting less than 20% PGSC Share on Additional Ticket will be summarily rejected.
- 2.4 The PGSC share will be calculated on base rate of ticket (without taxes on ticket) after deduction of commissions paid to registered tour operators of PGSC, any type of approved discounts {discounts offered to Senior Citizen, Divyaang (Physically handicapped), orphans, BPL (Below Poverty Line), War Widow Families, Student Discounts, Bulk Scheme Discounts etc. time to time} plus taxes as applicable from time to time and taxes on such share shall be extra as applicable. The payment on account of revenue will be settled fortnightly.
- 2.5 PGSC may consider for periodic revision of additional ticket rate based on escalation in price index.

## **3. Contract period**

- 3.1 The period of contract shall be for **FIVE years** from the date of start, which shall be indicated in the award letter.
- 3.2 Grace period of 4 **months** for installation or Setting up of Robotic Dinosaurs will be provided and after that contract period will commence.
- 3.3 Extension of Contract Period
- 3.3.1 If PGSC finds the work of contractor satisfactory and Contractor also desires to continue operations of Robotic Dinosaurs at Science City then contract can be extended on mutually agreed terms & conditions.
- 3.3.2 The Security Deposit will be withheld for the extended period and no interest will be payable.

## **4. Security**

- 4.1 The Bidders shall deposit EMD of Rs. 50,000/- at the time of deposit of tender. EMD of the successful bidder will be kept as Security Amount for the

duration of the contract period. It will be returned only after the completion of the contract / extended contract period.

- 4.1.1 The earnest money deposited with PGSC will be refunded to the unsuccessful tenderer after award of work to successful bidder.
- 4.1.2 In case successful Tenderer does not return the signed copy of the Agreement within 15 days of the issue of the intent letter, the earnest money shall be forfeited by the PGSC and the offer shall be treated as cancelled.
- 4.2 Successful Bidder will deposit additional Rs. 50,000/- or Bank Guarantee of equivalent amount with PGSC as a part of Security Deposit at the time of award of contract. It will be returned only after the completion of the contract / extended contract period.
- 4.3 No interest will be payable on EMD / Security Deposit.
- 4.4 The Security deposit is liable to be forfeited wholly or partially if:
  - 4.4.1 The standard of models and services deteriorates during the tenure of contract.
  - 4.4.2 Persistent Misbehavior of contractor or his employees.
  - 4.4.3 Any damage is caused by the contractor / his or her employee(s) or caused to be allowed to any person to the other existing models or island, equipment and any other things belonging to PGSC
  - 4.4.4 The contractor declines to render services at the rates agreed upon, due to any reason.
  - 4.4.5 Contractor fails to fulfill any terms & Conditions of the agreement.
  - 4.4.6 As per the termination clause.

## **5. Responsibilities of Firm / Contractor**

- 5.1 Firm / Contractor shall follow and comply with Requirements / ACTS / Rules / Notifications by Government and Guidelines provided for such activities
- 5.2 Comply with rules and notifications of Ministry of Labour, Government of Punjab.
- 5.3 Comply with Statutory and tax compliances
- 5.4 Indemnify PGSC against any such violation of rules / requirements etc found by authorized Agencies during inspections or otherwise.
- 5.5 Electricity bill on account of setup and subsequent operations of Robotic Dinosaurs will be paid by the contractor. A separate sub meter shall be installed for this purpose. The rate of electricity shall be the same, which PGSC will pay to Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd. (PSPCL). Electricity Bill to be payable by 10<sup>th</sup> day of next English calendar month.
- 5.6 The contractor will not transfer or sublet the contract.
- 5.7 The models shall also be kept in excellent safe operative conditions.
- 5.8 The contractor will arrange and provide all other auxiliary and support infrastructure or equipment for operations and maintenance of the facility.

5.9 The contractor will depute sufficient number of staff to ensure the smooth and proper operations during the working hours of the Science City.

**6. Terms & Conditions about employees of the contractor**

6.1 The contractor shall certify that the age of workers deployed is more than 18 years and shall comply with all the statutory requirements.

6.2 The contractor shall pay the minimum wages as prescribed by the Ministry of Labour, Government of Punjab to the persons engaged by him / her and abide by other Labour Laws like ID Act, Shops & Establishments, Employees Insurance, Factory Act etc.

6.3 The Contractor will furnish a list of his employees with their names, father's name, correspondence address as well as permanent address, date of birth and photographs to the PGSC for record.

6.4 The contractor shall provide identity cards and uniforms to all his staff at his own cost.

6.5 The contractor will be responsible for observing all the legal requirement / obligations / statutory compliance regarding working conditions of his employees under various labour, service, ESI, PF and other laws which may be in force.

6.6 Neither contractor nor any of his employees will perform the duty in drunken condition and if the contractor or any of his employees is found in such state, it may result in a fine of Rs. 2000/- for the first time and Rs. 5000/- for each subsequent offence(s).

6.7 In case any legal action is brought about by any of the employees of the contractor for any grievance in regard to his service conditions, benefits or any other loss or injury suffered during performance of his duties etc. the entire responsibility shall be of the contractor, who shall indemnify PGSC against any such claim.

6.8 The behaviour of the contractor and his employees with the visitors and the staff of PGSC shall be polite and courteous. The employee of the contractor, who will be dealing with the public shall be at least matriculate, smart, well mannered and of co-operative attitude. No person other than those mentioned in the list shall be placed on duty. Further they shall be in proper uniform and have nameplate on their left chest side as prescribed by the PGSC. Any employee of the contractor shall be liable to pay an amount of Rs 2000/- as penalty to the PGSC in case of default of above. If such violation continues 3 times, the contractor would be required to terminate that employee. Further if any dispute occurs with any visitor, the matter shall be immediately referred to the nominee of the Director General of the PGSC, whose decision in the matter shall be final and binding.

6.9 In case the contractor or his employees are found guilty of moral turpitude or any anti-social activity, the agreement may be cancelled by the PGSC.

Besides, PGSC will be at liberty to take criminal / civil action as per provision of law against such person.

- 6.10 PGSC will not be responsible for payment of any type, on account of any loss occurring due to employees of the contractor for which the contractor shall be exclusively liable.
- 6.11 In case of any mishap or any accident in the contract space, the contractor shall be solely responsible for civil damages and criminal action and the contractor shall indemnify PGSC. Also it will be the responsibility of the contractor to shift the person / persons on this account to a suitable medical facility at his cost and meeting his/her medical expenses, if so required.

## **7. Premises**

- 7.1 The contractor will not make any kind of excavation or construction including alteration or modification in the premises without the permission of PGSC in writing and further, he shall have no right to use PGSC property for his/her employee's personal purpose. The contractor shall not remove any such alteration or modification in the premises without the permission of PGSC in writing at the expiry of contract or extended period thereof.
- 7.2 The contractor will not alter or damage PGSC's property including electrical appliances, sanitary fittings and other fitting/ equipments as well the plantation work provided in the premises. In fact he shall be responsible for its care and safety, failing which he will be liable to pay its cost as decided by the PGSC. PGSC has the authority to inspect the space any time without giving any notice to the contractor.
- 7.3 The contractor will keep the premises in good, clean and hygienic order and maintain it in its original and aesthetic shape.
- 7.4 The contractor will not use or permit others to use the premises for the publicity purpose in any shape or form.
- 7.5 The contractor will not encroach upon the rights of other contractors, running their business in the PGSC premises.
- 7.6 On termination of contract, the contractor will hand over the site(s) to PGSC in the condition / manner it was received except as provided elsewhere herein, else PGSC will have the right to deduct cleaning / repair cost from the Security (EMD) or other dues payable or charge the contractor for the same.

## **8. Penal Rent**

If the contractor fails to vacate the premises after the expiry of the contract period owing to any reason, whatsoever, the contractor shall pay the penal rent of Rs.10,000/- per day for such period the premises remains in his possession after expiry of Contract or the extended period, as the case may be.

## **9. Other Important Conditions**

- 9.1 Contractor will be responsible for having cordial relations with all stake holders.
- 9.2 The contractor will be himself / herself responsible for insurance of his / her goods and will indemnify PGSC from any losses due to operations, fire, theft, force majeure etc.
- 9.3 Bidders are advised to visit the site and inspect the facilities available at the PGSC. For any clarification, Director may be contacted.

## **10. Obligations of the Pushpa Gujral Science City**

- 10.1 Proper supply of power will be made by the PGSC.
- 10.2 Standard illumination will be provided by the PGSC in the island. However, if any extra illumination is needed by the contractor, the contractor will arrange the same by incurring expenditure on its capital and expenses for its proper use and maintenance will be borne by the contractor, on the terms mutually settled by the PGSC and contractor.
- 10.3 Ticketing / Billing Software, if required will be provided by PGSC, which will be connected with the Server of PGSC.
- 10.4 Release of payments as per clause no.: 2.
- 10.5 Electricity Sub Meter will be installed.

## **11. Termination of Contract**

- 11.1 The contract can be terminated by either party after giving 6 months notice.
- 11.2 Without prejudice to other provisions herein, the contract can be terminated by PGSC by giving a prior notice of 3 months on violation of conditions of contract or on the grounds of default of proper services or setting up of models and their maintenance and operations by contractor. For operation of this clause a Consultative Committee of four representatives, two each from each party shall be constituted by the Director General, which shall meet from time to time and submit their deliberations to the Director General. The Director of the Science City or any other person authorized by the Director General, PGSC will be Chairman of the Committee.
- 11.3 In case of termination of the contract during the contract period, in the violation of clause 4 of the agreement, security Deposit will be forfeited.
- 11.4 In case of termination of the contract by the contractor, during the contract period, Contractor shall not remove his / her any equipment from the PGSC site without the permission of the PGSC, before full and final adjustment / settlement of accounts.
- 11.5 In case of termination of contract for convenience of both the parties i.e. PGSC and contractor who mutually agree to terminate the contract, the contractor will keep running the services as per the terms and conditions for 3 months.

11.6 In case contractor discontinues its operations without any notice, the assets of the contractor at PGSC, Kapurthala will be confiscated. The confiscated assets will be the property of PGSC. Contractor will not have any claim on the assets so confiscated whatsoever.

**12. Any Disputes in Day to Day Operations**

For removing difficulties and for operating the contract on day to day basis and resolving mutual problems in an amicable manner, a standing committee consisting of two representatives of PGSC and two representatives of the contractor shall be constituted, which will be headed by the person nominated by the Director General, PGSC. The decision / settlement arrived at there in shall be binding.

**13. Arbitration**

13.1 All disputes between PGSC and the contractor arising out of this agreement entered into or in relation thereto or regarding the interpretation of any clause, terms and conditions thereof shall be referred to the Director General, Pushpa Gujral Science City acting as such at the time of reference or any other person as may be nominated by the DG who will be the sole arbitrator and his decision will be final and binding. In case the nominated Arbitrator is unable to commence or continue with the Arbitral proceedings for any reason whatsoever, the DG shall nominate / appoint another officer of PGSC who shall commence the proceedings and decide the reference. The provision of Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 shall apply.

13.2 The place for arbitration will be Kapurthala.

# **INSTRUCTIONS**

## **Contract for installation and operations of Robotic Dinosaurs**

### **1. PRE-BID MEETING**

- 1.1 A pre-bid meeting shall be held for clarifying any issue raised by the prospective bidders. The prospective bidders may send their queries in advance preferably.
- 1.2 The minutes of the pre-bid meeting shall be posted on the website of PGSC on next working day.
- 1.3 Decisions taken in the pre-bid meeting shall have overriding effects on the provisions mentioned in scope, terms and conditions of the Tender Document.

### **2. The offer should be submitted in three separate envelopes.**

Part - I (Envelope - I): containing Earnest Money Deposit of Rs.50,000/- plus Rs. 1000/- (cost of tender document, if downloaded from the website) or PGSC receipt of Rs. 1000/- against the purchase of Tender Document

Part - II (Envelope - II): containing Technical Bid

Part - III (Envelope - III): containing Financial Bid

### **3. The tender shall be submitted as under: -**

**ENVELOPE – I:** superscribed "**EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT**" should contain

- Earnest Money Deposit in the form of Demand Draft for Rs. 50,000/-

#### 4. PROCEDURE

The procedure of opening the tender shall be as follows:
